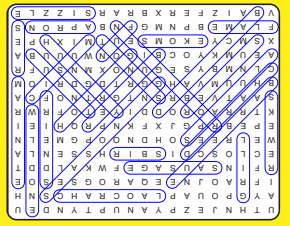

NEIL ARMSTRONG LEFT HIS SHOES ON THE MOON!

After Neil Armstrong took one of the most consequential steps in human history, the boots he used to do so were discarded on the moon. In fact, both of the Apollo 11 astronauts who walked on the lunar surface — Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin — left behind their overshoes, along with their portable life-support systems. Leaving the gear wasn't a symbolic gesture; it helped to offset the added weight of collected moon rocks that the shuttle would be taking back. And the astronauts didn't return to Earth barefoot, either. The treaded overshoes they abandoned were worn atop flat-soled pressure boots, which they kept.

WHEN DID MOTHER'S DAY BECOME AN OFFICIAL U.S. HOLIDAY? ANSWER: 1914

Holding celebrations to honor mothers is traceable back to the ancient Greeks and Romans. They held annual festivals in honor of the mother goddesses Rhea and Cybele. The celebration closest to modern times that may have spawned what's become traditional Mother's Day is the early Christian celebration known as "Mothering Sunday." The holiday originally fell on the 4th Sunday in Lent in the U.K. and parts of Europe. The custom faded over time eventually re-emerging in popularity as the American Mother's Day in the 1930s and 1940s. It was officially declared a U.S. holiday in 1914, however.

BUTTERY SHRIMP WITH PEAS & POTATOES

May 10th is National Shrimp Day!

Creamy new potatoes add substance to this quick one-pan skillet dinner of tender shrimp, fresh shelling peas, and dill, which come together in a sweet and buttery broth laced with cream.



• Total Time: 30 mins • Servings: 4

Ingredients

| • 5 cups water | • ¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil | • 12 ounces peeled and deveined tail-on raw large shrimp |
| • 2 tablespoons plus 1 tsp. kosher salt, divided, plus more to taste | • 1 medium shallot, finely chopped (about 1/3 cup) | • ¼ tsp. black pepper, plus more to taste |
| • 8 ounces baby gold potatoes, cut into ¼-inch-thick slices (about 1 ¾ cups) | • 1 medium-size fresh Fresno chile, stemmed, seeded (if desired), and finely chopped (about 2 Tbsp.) | • 1 cup lower-sodium chicken broth |
| • 8 ounces shelled fresh or frozen English peas (about 1 ½ cups) | • 4 medium garlic cloves, finely chopped (about 4 tsp.) | • ¼ cup heavy cream |
| • ¼ cup unsalted butter | • 1/3 cup dry white wine | • 1/3 cup chopped fresh dill |
| | | • Crusty bread, for serving |

Directions

1. Bring 5 cups water to a boil in a 12-inch skillet over medium-high. Stir in 2 tablespoons salt. Add potatoes; cook, stirring occasionally, until barely tender, 5 to 7 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer to a plate. Add peas to boiling water; cook, stirring occasionally, until crisp-tender, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove skillet from heat. Drain peas in a colander; rinse under cold water until cool to the touch, about 15 seconds. Set aside.
2. Wipe skillet dry using paper towels. Add butter and oil to skillet; cook over medium-high until butter is melted. Add shallot, chile, garlic, and 1/2 teaspoon salt; cook, stirring often, until mixture is fragrant and softened, 2 to 3 minutes. Add wine; cook, stirring occasionally, until wine is almost completely reduced, about 2 minutes.
3. Add shrimp to skillet in a single layer; sprinkle with black pepper and remaining ½ teaspoon salt. Cook, undisturbed, until shrimp are partially opaque, about 2 minutes. Flip shrimp, and immediately add broth and potatoes to skillet. Bring to a simmer over medium-high; simmer, stirring occasionally, until shrimp are almost cooked through, about 1 minute. Add peas and cream; cook, stirring occasionally, until heated through, about 30 seconds. Remove from heat. Season with additional salt and black pepper to taste. Sprinkle with dill and serve with crusty bread.
