#### **MEMORIAL DAY – BET YOU DIDN'T KNOW...**

- The day was originally set aside to remember Union soldiers who died during the Civil War, but following World War I, its scope expanded to include those who died in any war or military action.
- The idea for a specific holiday came in 1868 from Illinois Senator John Alexander Logan, a former Union



- general and keynote speaker at one early observation.
- Originally called "Decoration Day," the name "Memorial Day" became more common after World War II, and in 1967 was declared the official name by Federal law.
- Memorial Day was celebrated on May 30 until 1968, when Congress passed the Uniform Holidays Bill, moving 4 holidays — Columbus Day, Presidents' Day, Veterans Day and Memorial Day—to designated Mondays in order to create the ever-popular three-day weekend!


